

Reception Class Curriculum Map 1st Half of Summer Term 2022

Communication, Language and Literacy

Main texts:

Emergency by Margaret Mayo and Alex Ayliffe
The Train ride by June Crebbin
The Naughty Bus by Jan Oke
Usborne book of Big Trucks (Non-fiction)
Topsy and Tim go on an aeroplane by Jean & Gareth Adamson

Skills:

- To continue to learn phase 3 sounds and the alphabet.
- Introduce Phase 5 sounds.
- To segment and blend words to create words with three sounds.
- To write simple sentences about stories/information they have read.
- To retell stories in order using story maps.
- To find information from non-fiction texts.

Understanding the World

- Explore different forms of transport (past and present)
- Learn about floating and sinking by building miniature boats.
- Explore friction by rolling cars down different textured ramps.
- Use maps to consider where we'd like to visit.
- Use iPads to explore Google Earth and code bee-bots to move around a map.
- Show an awareness that some people belong to different religions.

Mathematics

- Exploring number 11 to 20
- Add to a number by counting on and take away from a number by counting back
- Doubling and halving numbers to 20
- Sharing equally
- Odd and even numbers
- Time (O'clock)
- Recap on Money value.
- Numerical patterns
- Recap - Number bonds to 10

Are we there yet?



This topic is all about transport, travel and places near and far. The children will explore questions such as where in the world would you like to go and how would you travel there?

Physical Development

- To develop balancing skills on different types of equipment in the outdoor area.
- Use fine motor skills in our Funky Fingers area.
- During PE lessons we will be focusing on tennis skills. We will learn to hold the bat correctly, balance a ball on a bat, aim a serve using a drop and hit technique and hit a ball back to a partner.

Expressive Arts and Design

- We'll use junk model materials to make different forms of transport.
- We'll use collage materials to make our own hot air balloons.

- We focus on road safety rules and look at the important clothing people have to wear when travelling on certain modes of transport.
- In our PSHE sessions this term we will be looking at friendships and how to be a good friend. In addition, the children will be working on regulating incidents within their friendships groups and how to resolve conflict.
