Speaking and listening

Ask relevant questions to extend understanding and knowledge.
Give well-structured descriptions, explanations and narratives for different purposes, including expressing feelings.
Maintain attention and participate actively in collaborative conversations, staying on topic and initiating and responding to comments.

Reading and Phonics

Daily phonics lessons revising all Phase 3 sounds and Phase 4 blends.
Practise of new Phase 5 sounds.
Class guided reading sessions to support children with their reading skills, with a focus on word meaning and finding information.
Segmenting and blending of sounds already learnt.
Discussion of texts during guided reading sessions for children to show their understanding of what had been read.
Learning to read by sight the Year 1 common exception words.

Writing

Compose sentences orally before writing them “holding a sentence”.
Sequence sentences to form short narratives (character descriptions/setting descriptions).
Spell year 1 common exception words.
Form capital letters and lower-case letters in the correct direction, starting and finishing in the right place.
Re-read own writing to check it makes sense.
Discuss what they have written with others.

Express their own ideas about the creation story.
