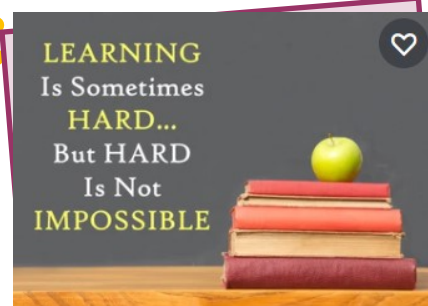
OTTERS & KINGFISHERS
