## Communication, Language and Literacy

### Main texts:

### Skills:

- To continue to learn phase 3 sounds and the alphabet.
- Introduce Phase 5 sounds.
- To segment and blend words to create words with three sounds.
- To write simple sentences about stories/ information they have read.
- To retell stories in order using story maps.
- To find information from non-fiction texts.

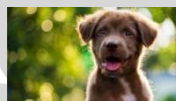
## Understanding the World

- We will talk about our own experiences with pets and farm animals.
- We will explore questions such as: What do animals have in common with each other? How do we look after different animals?
- We will link a pet visiting a vet to the children's own experiences of visiting a doctor or dentist.

## Our Spring Theme - 2<sup>nd</sup> Half Term

### Animals

During this topic the children will learn all about the important job of a vet. We will explore the different pets we own at home and how we care for different animals. We will also learn about bigger animals that live on farms.



## Mathematics

- Solve practical problems that involve combining groups of 2, 5 or 10 or sharing into equal groups
- Explore counting on in steps of 2 from zero
- Count reliably with numbers from one to 20. Place numbers from 0-20 in order.
- Say which number is 1 more or 1 less than a given number.
- Solve practical problems that involve grouping

- In PE we will be learning skills in hockey.
- We will continue to practice our pre cursive handwriting. Remember all children have logins to use the Letterjoin programme at home.
