

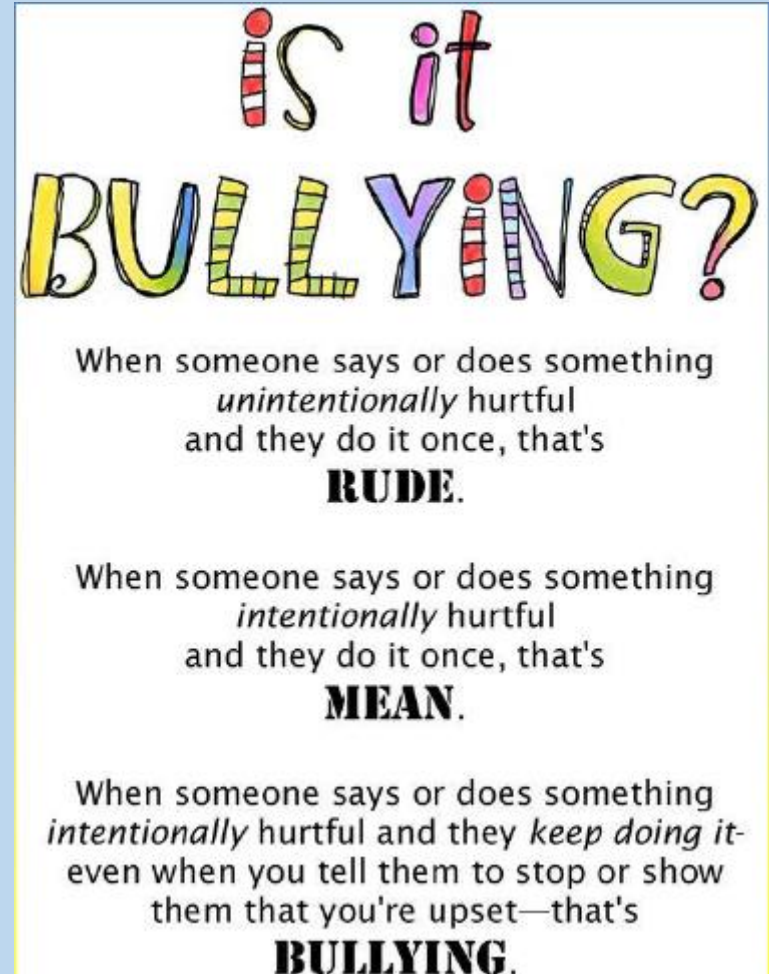

# There is no legal definition for the word bullying

We are going to be using the rude, mean, bullying guide to help us identify whether a child's actions can be deemed as bullying.



## What does rude mean?

When someone does or says something  
unintentionally hurtful and they do this  
once that's



Rude!

## What does mean mean?

When someone does or says something intentionally hurtful and they do this once that's

***Mean!***

## What does bullying mean?

When someone does or says something intentionally hurtful and *they keep doing it*- even when you tell them to stop or they can see you are upset- that's

**Bullying!**

- Unintentional
- Hurtful
- One-off

## Mean

- Intentional
- Hurtful
- One-off

## Bullying

- Intentional
- Hurtful
- Happens more than once, even when you ask them to stop or show that you're upset.

## What is this?

Simon and Jim are playing football. Jim throws the ball and it hits Simon in the face.

Jim says sorry and that he didn't mean it.



## What is this?

Jane sends one message to Lucy's friends online telling them they shouldn't talk to her because she is an idiot. She does this once.

## What is this?

Each time, over the space of a month, Remi is told she can't sit with a group of girls in her class to eat her lunch; she gets upset in front of them but they continue.



Bullying is rare!

# How can I stop bullying (Anti-bullying code)

- **Don't:** Take part in the bullying
- **Don't:** Get involved, tell an adult
- **Don't:** Ignore bullying
- **Do:** Listen if somebody tells you they are being bullied.
- **Do:** Encourage them to tell an adult what has been happening or offer to go with them to talk to a teacher or an adult or offer to tell an adult for them.

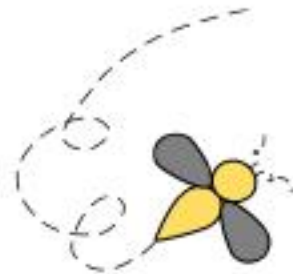


# Is it Bullying?



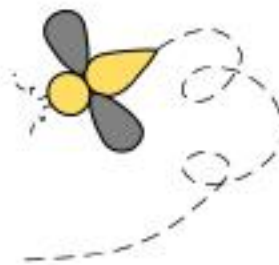
When someone says or does something unintentionally hurtful and they do it once.

**That's MEAN**

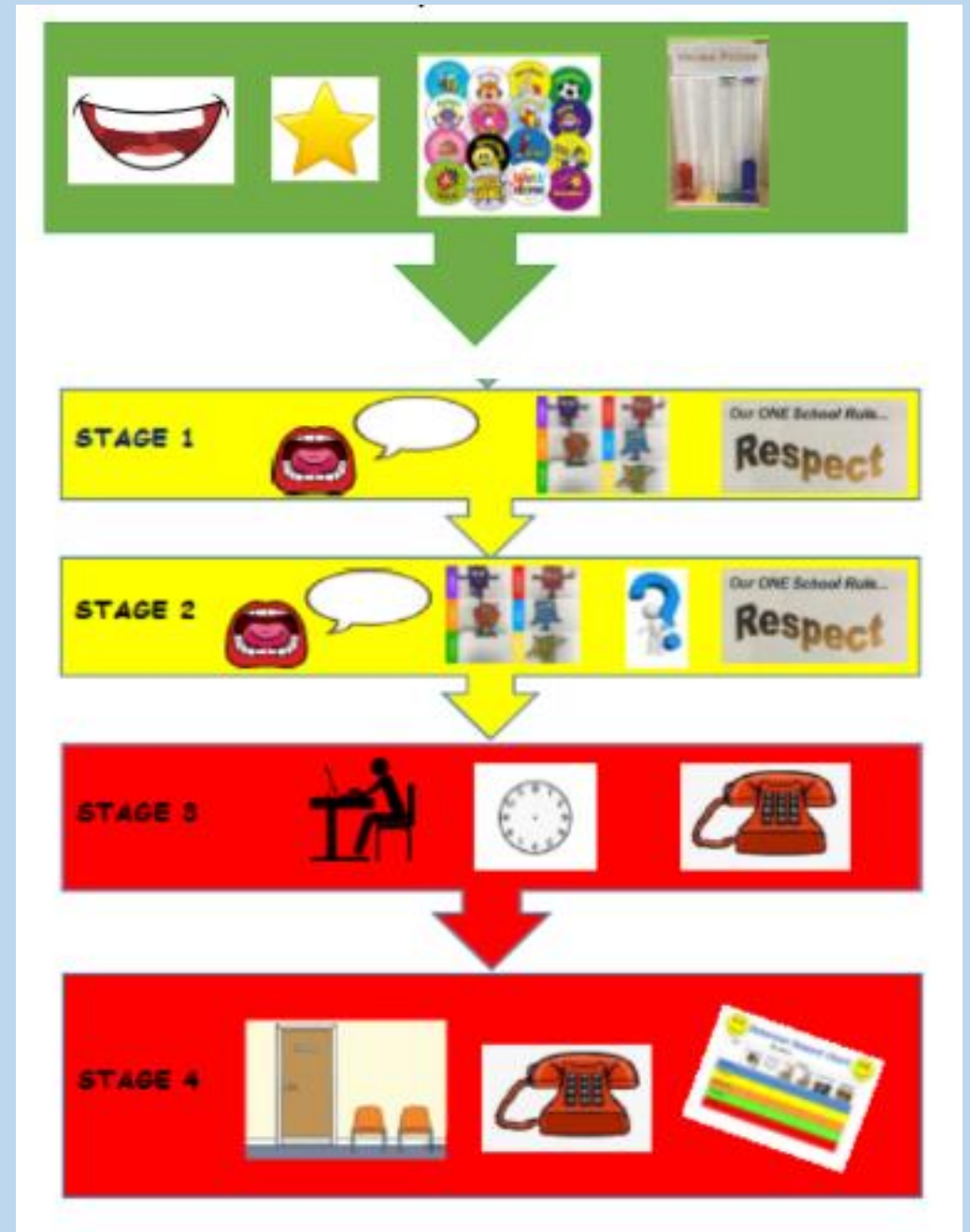


When someone says or does something intentionally hurtful and they keep doing it even when you tell them to stop or show them that you're upset.

**That's BULLYING**
