

Otters Class Curriculum Map – 1st Half of Autumn Term 2019

Maths

Numbers within 10

Count, read, write, identify, represent, double and half, and use comparative language.

Addition and subtraction within 10

Combination and partitioning. Represent and use number bonds; read, write, interpret, represent and solve.

Shapes and patterns

Recognise common 2-D and 3-D shapes; describe position, direction and movement.

English

Reading & phonics:

- Daily phonics lessons revising all Phase 3 sounds, and Phase 4 blends
- Practise of new Phase 5 sounds
- Class guided reading sessions to support children with their reading skills, with a focus on segmenting and blending of sounds already learnt
- Discussion of texts during guided reading sessions for children to show their understanding of what has been read
- Learning to read by sight the Year 1 common exception words

Writing

- Compose sentences orally before writing them, “holding a sentence”
- Sequence sentences to form short narratives
- Spell Year 1 common exception words
- Form capital letters and lower-case letters in the correct direction, starting and finishing in the right place
- Re-read own writing to check it makes sense
- Discuss what they have written with others

Science – Animals Including Humans

Geography

- Use an atlas and globe to identify the countries of the UK

Art and Design

- Talking about different art forms
- Drawing, collage and animal sculptures
